

The Eleventh Trifolium Conference will be held at the Silver Falls Conference Center, Sublimity, OR from 9-11 July 1990. The Trifolium Conference is held every two years to provide a forum at which clover and special purpose legume researchers can exchange information and discuss common problems and goals. The Conference will include an overview of forage legume research in Oregon, voluntary paper and poster sessions, work sessions on legume seed production and Kura clover, and a tour of seed research and production in the Willamette valley.
