RECURRENT SELECTION IN Birdsfoot Trefoil

Two cycles of recurrent selection for seed yield, and three cycles of recurrent selection for seed size and seedling vigor have been completed at the University of Guelph. About 200 selections resulting from these projects have now been cloned and are in the process of being screened for seed production under conditions simulating farm seedings. A paper entitled "Spacing Trials For Assessing Combining Ability Of Birdsfoot Trefoil Clones For Seed Yield" is being prepared.
